Pass prices go up for Wilson Pool on May 26

There's less than a month left to purchase discounted, pre-season passes for Wilson Pool this summer. The savings end when the pool opens on May 26.

Pre-passes can be purchased online at: www.westcarrollton. org/pre-season-pool-pass-registration/ or at the West Carrollton Civic Center, 300 E. Central Ave., from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day. Wilson Pool will also be open for sales from 9 a.m. to noon, on May 12 and May 19.
