Shown on this page are both sides of a record (Part 1 and Part 3) in a two-record set that contains a live-in-concert recording from the world premiere stage production of Benjamin Britten's *Saint Nicolas* with guest conductor Hugh Ross of New York's *Schola Cantorum*. (Part 1 label at right.) These may be the only recordings of the Chorus with the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra. They also include solos by tenor David Lloyd of the New York City Opera.
